Message from Mrs. Nellis:

Dear Families. We hope that you had a great Easter break, despite the disappointing weather. Hopefully, the sun will shine and the weather will warm up over the next few weeks. The children have returned to school raring to go, as always, and full of enthusiasm. The Y5 basketball team are taking part in the Champion of Champion finals at the Eagles this afternoon and we wish them all the best of luck! The Y6 football team also played some great league games last night and demonstrated some excellent sportsmanship.

Reporting absences - I cannot stress enough the importance of reporting your child's absence. You can report this via parentmail, by calling the school office or by sending an e mail to the main Glynwood email account. If we have not heard from you, we cannot get in touch with you and we are concerned about you or your child, then we will conduct a home visit. If a home visit fails, then we may ask other service to conduct a welfare check. Safeguarding is our number one priority and we have a responsibility to know that children are safe if they are not in school. Please inform school each day of your child's absence.

It is also important to be honest about the reason for absence. If you are on holiday, but school think that your child is absent due to sickness, then that puts everyone in a difficult position, particularly your child when they return to school.

After School Club - Please can you ensure that your child knows if they are attending After School Club whenever possible. Many thanks.

Spare clothing - If anyone has any outgrown spare clothing (jogging bottoms, leggings etc) in all sizes (to fit children right up to Y6), we would really appreciate donations. Children often fall over in the mud or need to get changed for other reasons, so spare clothing is always needed!

Lunchtimes - we are on a mission to make lunchtimes as enjoyable as possible. We have purchased some great new equipment for the children and there are now different areas for the children to access on the KS2 playground. The Playground Leaders (KS2 children) have been doing a great job supporting the children on the KS1 playground, but also ensuring that the new zones on the KS2 yard have been working well too. Lots of new activities will be introduced onto the KS1 yard in the next couple of weeks. Hopefully the children will also be able to access the play equipment on the grassed areas when the weather improves too.

Please do not allow your children to play on the fixed play equipment before or after school. This is for health and safety reasons.

We are delighted that the Easter raffle raised £499 - many thanks for your contributions and we hope that those of you who won enjoyed your hampers!
