Dear Families, I hope that this newsletter finds you well.

Mrs. Allom will be returning to her class Y1 AC working alongside Mrs. Brunskill who will be staying with the class, teaching as previously at the end of the week. Mrs. Commons will be teaching in Mrs. Wright's class every Friday and every other Thursday.

Mrs Dobbing has secured a position working as a counsellor with looked after children across the region, so unfortunately will no longer be working at Glynwood. We thank her for all of her hard work and fantastic work supporting children and families over the years whist at Glynwood and wish her the best of luck in her new job.

OFSTED - School is anticipating the initial report from OFSTED any time soon and copies should hopefully be made available to parents soon afterwards.

Christmas Dinner – If your child would like a Christmas dinner on Thursday 12th December please can you book it in on Parentmail as soon as possible. Please note we will only be serving a turkey dinner or a vegetarian dinner on this day. Please provide your child with a packed lunch if they do not want a Christmas dinner.

Spare clothes – we would really welcome donations of spare items of clothing, most useful would be underpants, knickers, socks and jogger bottoms – please drop off to a member of your child's classroom staff.

False Nails – Children have been discussing their upcoming Christmas parties next week. Please can you ensure your child does not go to get false nails for their party as they pose a health and safety risk to themselves and other pupils.

Drop off times – Please can we try to drop off children at <u>8:45 am</u> as there are still a number of families who are regularly arriving at 8:55 or later – this means your child is missing ten or 15 minutes of learning time on a regular basis and it is making it difficult to close our gates on time and secure the school promptly.

Earrings - a polite reminder that children should have their earrings taped up if they are unable to remove them for school.

Cold weather clothing – can we ask that pupils wear a warm coat for school and have hats and gloves if possible as some children are attending school only in their school jumpers. Remember to pop your child's name on any items they bring to school if you can to help avoid them getting lost.

Afterschool club/ breakfast club - Did you know that you can get help towards the costs. We are registered with the Government Tax-free childcare initiative, please see the attached flyer and click on the link. https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare our school post code is NE9 5SY.

Money Owing – Please can you check your balances in Parentmail for school meals, breakfast club and afterschool club. Any money owed must be paid before we break up for the Christmas holidays.

Reporting absences – if your child is going to be absent from school, it is essential that you let school know either through the ParentMail app or by phoning the school office. If we do not receive a reason for absence then we may conduct an unannounced home visit to ensure the welfare of the whole family.
